Each first place winner will take home \$100.00. Second and third place finishers will receive prizes or gift certificates. In addition, the highest scoring recipe will win the Best Taste of Ka`u with a cash prize of \$250.00! You are only allowed to compete in one of the three divisions, but you may compete in each of the categories in the division of your choice. The divisions are:

- **Professional** working chefs, culinary teachers or post-secondary students of the culinary arts.
- **Amateur** adults who simply enjoy cooking at home and cook for their own enjoyment and for the satisfaction of their family and friends.
- **Student** High School and Middle School students who enjoy cooking for their own enjoyment and for the satisfaction of their family and friends.

You are allowed to enter into more than one category in each of the below divisions. The categories are:

- **Appetizer, (Pupus)**
- **Entrée (Main Dish)**
- **Dessert**
- **Drink**

Through April 20, each entrant is entitled to pickup a free six-ounce bag of Ka`u Coffee per completed entry form to use for the creation of the recipes from R&G store in Pahala 928-8558

Important

- List all the ingredients that were grown in Ka`u, as using more Ka`u ingredients earns extra points.
- All entries must contain Ka`u coffee.
- All recipes must be alcohol-free.
- There will be no cooking at the Community Center as there will not be facilities available.
- You must plate and present your entry at the Pahala Community Center no later than 1 p.m. on May 1st.

The entries will be presented to the judges anonymously, for blind judging. The winners will be announced after the judging. You do not need to be present during the judging to win. Recipes will be included in a Ka`u Coffee Festival Cookbook. By entering the contest, entrants give the Ka`u Coffee Festival Committee permission to publish their recipes.
